We are now in the bottom half of all 50 states. Most alarming is the fact that Indiana ranks 42nd in Infrastructure (only five states are ranked below Indiana).

"Bicycle Indiana is very concerned about our state's ranking as a bicycle-friendly state. We're calling a summit to address this issue and asking bicyclists to join us and be part of the solution," Nancy Tibbett, Executive Director, Bicycle Indiana.
